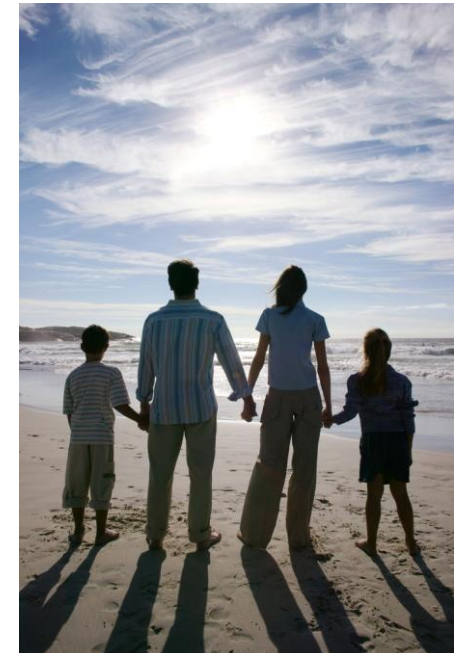

Who We Are

AFCS Treatment Foster Care provides a permanent place for kids while helping them develop the skills to shape their own future. Our motto and daily focus is that if we take care of the foster family, they will take care of the children.

Our team philosophy of family support is what sets our agency apart from other treatment agencies as each child is surrounded by a team of caring professionals.

Our History

In 1998 the idea of a Treatment Foster Care program was approved by the AFCS Board. In December of 1999 AFCS was granted their child placing agency license. In January of 2000 the first child was placed. By the end of 2000 there were 2 part-time staff, 6 foster homes, and 13 foster children.

As of mid 2009 we have 7 full-time staff, 18 licensed homes and are licensed to place 50 children in treatment foster care. We are supported by the Board of Directors, the Leadership team, the support and clinical staff of AFCS.

Target Population

The majority of the children in our program are between the ages of 5 and 17, although there are exceptions. Virtually all of these children have experienced traumatic events to varying degrees, such as neglect, abandonment, abuse and violence. This trauma results in the severe behaviors that are brought into foster care. Children are placed in our program on either a protection or delinquency order.

Children in Treatment Foster Care have very intense needs, which make our work challenging but rewarding. We have seen children make great strides in their healing, and most develop the ability to transition either back home to their family, or to Independent Living.
